"Grace and truth came [or subsists] through Jesus Christ" (John 1:17b ASV, and Darby in brackets). The Greek word for "came" is "ginomai" which means "has come"—signifying that that which before had never actually been in being in the world now begins to be so. In other words, grace actually commenced to be, yet not in God's mind, of course, but in revelation and actual existence down here on the earth (see Darby's footnote discussion on "subsists" in John 1:17).
