Like many other Burroughs stories, *A Fighting Man of Mars* resembles *The Arabian Nights*. The story is purportedly relayed back to earth via the Gridley Wave, a sort of super radio frequency previously introduced in *Tanar of Pellucidar*, the third of Burrough's *Pellucidar* novels, which thus provides a link between the two series.
