

Applied Thermodynamics By Rs Khurmi

Engineering Thermodynamics has been designed for students of all branches of engineering specially undergraduate students of Mechanical Engineering. The book will also serve as reference manual for practising engineers. The book has been written in simple language and systematically develops the concepts and principles essential for understanding the subject. The text has been supplemented with solved numerical problems, illustrations and question banks. The text begins by reviewing, in a simple and precise manner, the physical principles of three pillars of Refrigeration and Air Conditioning, namely thermodynamics, heat transfer, and fluid mechanics. Following an overview of the history of refrigeration, subsequent chapters provide exhaustive coverage of the principles, applications and design of several types of refrigeration systems and their associated components such as compressors, condensers, evaporators, and expansion devices. Refrigerants too, are studied elaboratively in an exclusive chapter. The second part of the book, beginning with the historical background of air conditioning in Chapter 15, discusses the subject of psychrometrics being at the heart of understanding the design and implementation of air conditioning processes and systems, which are subsequently dealt with in Chapters 16 to 23. It also explains the design practices followed for cooling and heating load calculations. Each chapter contains several worked-out examples that clarify the material discussed and illustrate the use of basic principles in engineering applications. Each chapter also ends with a set of few review questions to serve as revision of the material learned.

Thermodynamics is a simple but a little difficult to comprehend subject because most of the theories were evolved over a period by means of experiments and measurements. This book will help students understand and appreciate the basics of thermodynamics starting from the fundamentals. The subject matter has been organized into 14 chapters in a logical sequence which covers both basic and applied thermodynamics. The theory is presented in a lucid manner with practical examples, wherever necessary. Each chapter consists of solved examples, review questions, exercise problems and MCQs, thereby helping students to apply the concepts learnt in the chapter.
