Beginning with 'The Liberators of the Mind', the author discusses important thinkers of the time, such as Tolstoy and Nietzsche. The second part looks at 'The War and the Peace', which refers to the recently fought First World War. He then moves on to 'Education and Society', where discussions include Bahaim and Father Christmas. The final part looks at 'Art and Criticism', discussing the trends of French post-war poetry – realism, symbolism and dynamism – followed by a look at dynamic drawing. This volume is available again after many years out of print. This general monograph on the Baha'is and their religion places new emphasis on the sociology of contemporary Baha'i, including a thorough case study of a European Baha'i community and of the life at the Baha'i World Centre.
