Moto-journalist Clement Salvadori has been riding motorcycles since the age of 15 and traveling all of his life, accumulating well over a million miles in the saddle across more than 70 countries on six continents. The stories are all original, though the subject may have appeared as a magazine article in a very different rendition.
