He published an article on The Question of Ireland in The Freemans Journal, September 9th, 1848, blaming the insurgents for their lack of organization, recommending Catholics to give them no more money, and intimating that little of what was given reached its destination. They could do no good, and were not only foolish, but dangerous and wicked.
