En la introducción al Memorial de Sololá anuncia el autor que va a escribir las historias de sus antepasados, tal como ellos solían contarlas; cómo llegó su pueblo, desde el otro lado del mar, a la legendaria Tulán, núcleo de las razas de México y Guatemala, y cómo, después de organizarse, los guerreros de las siete tribus emprendieron el viaje hacia el sur, buscando los montes y valles donde debían fijarse y prosperar bajo el Sol de la civilización. Es interesante notar que el manuscrito cakchiquel, lo mismo que el Popol Vuh y demás documentos quichés y los Libros de Chilam Balam, señalan a la legendaria Tula como el centro de difusión de las razas que poblaron las tierras de la Península de Yucatán y el interior de la actual República de Guatemala. Aunque entre los arqueólogos e historiadores ha habido discrepancia acerca de la localización de Tula, hoy parece un hecho establecido que la ciudad prehistórica era la misma cuyas espléndidas ruinas se contemplan al norte de la capital de México, en el Estado de Hidalgo, en el centro de la zona de Tula-Jilotepec. Adrián Recinos Francisco Hernández Arana Xajilá y Francisco Rojas son considerados los autores del Memorial de Sololá.

In communities throughout precontact Mesoamerica, calendar priests and diviners relied on pictographic almanacs to predict the fate of newborns, to guide people in choosing marriage partners and auspicious wedding dates, to know when to plant and harvest crops, and to be successful in many of life's activities. As the Spanish colonized Mesoamerica in the sixteenth century, they made a determined effort to destroy these books, in which the Aztec and neighboring peoples recorded their understanding of the invisible world of the sacred calendar and the cosmic forces and supernaturals that adhered to time. Today, only a few of these divinatory codices survive. Visually complex, esoteric, and strikingly beautiful, painted books such as the famous *Codex Borgia* and *Codex Borbonicus* still serve as portals into the ancient Mexican calendrical systems and the cycles of time and meaning they encode. In this comprehensive study, Elizabeth Hill Boone analyzes the entire extant corpus of Mexican divinatory codices and offers a masterful explanation of the genre as a whole. She introduces the sacred, divinatory calendar and the calendar priests and diviners who owned and used the books. Boone then explains the graphic vocabulary of the calendar and its prophetic forces and describes the organizing principles that structure the codices. She shows how they form almanacs that either offer general purpose guidance or focus topically on specific aspects of life, such as birth, marriage, agriculture and rain, travel, and the forces of the planet Venus. Boone also tackles two major areas of controversy—the

great narrative passage in the Codex Borgia, which she freshly interprets as a cosmic narrative of creation, and the disputed origins of the codices, which, she argues, grew out of a single religious and divinatory system.

It also emphasizes the importance of the events that trigger reform and the designers' level of electoral uncertainty for understanding the relative impact of short-term partisan

interests on constitution writing. Negretto's study challenges predominant theories of institutional choice, and paves the way for the development of a new research agenda on institutional change.

Studies have shown that learning outcomes are related to the amount of time students engage in learning tasks. However, visits to schools have revealed that students are often taught for only a fraction of the intended time, particularly in lower-income countries. Losses are due to informal school closures, teacher



absenteeism, delays, early departures, and sub-optimal use of time in the classroom. A study was undertaken to develop an efficient methodology for measuring instructional time loss. Thus, instructional time use was measured in sampled schools in Tunisia, Morocco, Ghana, and the Brazilian state of Pernambuco. The percentage of time that students were engaged in learning vis-à-vis government expectations was approximately 39 percent in Ghana, 63 percent in Pernambuco, 71 percent in Morocco, and 78 percent in Tunisia. Instructional time use is a mediator variable that is challenging to measure, so it often escapes scrutiny. Research suggests that merely financing the ingredients of instruction is not enough to produce learning outcomes; students must also get sufficient time to process the information. The quantity-quality tradeoff that often accompanies large-scale enrollments may be partly due to instructional time restrictions. Time wastage also distorts budgetary outlays and teacher salary rates. To achieve the Millennium Development Goals students must get more of the time that governments, donors, and parents pay for.
