Instead, this volume examines key elements in the design and implementation of micronutrient interventions, including such issues as: The importance of iron, vitamin A, and iodine to health. Populations at risk for micronutrient deficiency. Options for successful interventions and their cost. The feasibility of involving societal sectors in the planning and implementation of interventions. Characteristics of successful interventions. The book also contains

three in-depth background papers that address the prevention of deficiencies of iron, vitamin A, and iodine.

This textbook provides an overview of pain management useful to specialists as well as non-specialists, surgeons, and nursing staff.

This book sheds new light on neurodegenerative disorders as systemic diseases. Classically, neuronal cell death was a hallmark of such disorders.
