Special emphasis is given to perspectives on the chemoprevention of breast cancer, as the conference included an international consensus meeting on this subject. New research findings are presented and potentially more effective cancer prevention strategies are discussed, with careful consideration of controversies. The expertise of the contributors encompasses genetics and microbiology, epidemiology, and health economics, as well as clinical cancer prevention. This book will be of interest to all who wish to learn about the most recent progress in combating the development of cancer.

Interest in the role of extracellular vesicles (microvesicles and exosomes) is expanding rapidly. This book introduces and discusses the most important aspects of clinical research methods and biostatistics for oncologists, pursuing a tailor-made and practical approach. Evidence-based medicine (EBM) has been in vogue in the last few decades, particularly in rapidly advancing fields such as oncology. This approach has been used to support decision-making processes worldwide, sparking new clinical research and guidelines on clinical and surgical oncology.

Clinical oncology research has many peculiarities, including specific study endpoints, a special focus on survival analyses, and a unique perspective on EBM. However, during medical studies and in general practice, these topics are barely taught. Moreover, even when EBM and clinical cancer research are discussed, they are presented in a theoretical fashion, mostly focused on formulas and numbers, rather than on clinical application for a proper literature appraisal. Addressing that gap, this book discusses more practical aspects of clinical research and biostatistics in oncology, instead of relying only on mathematical formulas and theoretical considerations. *Methods and Biostatistics in Oncology* will help readers develop the skills they need to understand the use of research on everyday oncology clinical practice for study design and interpretation, as well to demystify the use of EBM in oncology.

Diagnostic cytology has recently enjoyed increased attention and significance in modern research. Essential information on latest developments in methods and applications in cytology is provided by this book. Chapters review methodological advances, such as in cancer detection, and explore potential relationships to molecular biology. Also discussed are: viral infection, fundamentals of quantitative methods, and the revolutionary role of immunocytochemistry in diagnostic cell typing. Desde el año 1986, la Comisión de la Especialidad de Aparato Digestivo de nuestro país, a instancias de la Asociación Española de Ecografía Digestiva (AEED) estableció la obligatoriedad de la ecografía en el programa de formación del residente de Aparato Digestivo. Aunque no está concretado el tiempo necesario de rotación por la Unidad de Ecografía, parece evidente que al ser una técnica muy explorador dependiente, con una curva de aprendizaje relativamente lenta, este tiempo no debería ser inferior a los seis meses. La importancia de una buena formación ecográfica es fundamental para el gastroenterólogo. La disponibilidad y fiabilidad que implica el que el mismo especialista de aparato digestivo realice la exploración ecográfica de sus enfermos cuyos síntomas conoce en detalle, ofrece una capacidad diagnóstica probablemente superior a la que pueda ofrecer otro profesional que lógicamente no tiene los mismos conocimientos clínicos de nuestra especialidad. La elaboración de este Tratado surgió de esta necesidad de formación y actualización ecográfica, que constituye la esencia y el sentido de existir de la AEED y de la conciencia clara de que no existía una publicación que recogiera los diferentes aspectos ecográficos necesarios para un desarrollo integral de nuestra especialidad. This book introduces molecular imaging and Target Therapy in various cancers. The first part is the subjects and primary focused on the basics of nuclear physics, radiation

dosimetry, nuclear medicine equipment and small animal imaging equipment. The second part is about the radiopharmaceutical and commonly used clinical radiopharmaceuticals, including positron emission imaging agent, single photon emission imaging agent, and radionuclide therapy agents as well as their radioactive preparation, quality control, and a brief clinical application were included. Also, this part introduces a number of new imaging agents which were potential value of clinical applications. In the third part, the clinical application of the conventional imaging agent ^{18}F -FDG in different tumors and neurodegenerative diseases and ^{18}F -Dopa imaging in the nervous system are discussed. Besides the clinical applications of $^{99\text{m}}\text{Tc}$ labeled radiopharmaceuticals in parathyroid disease, coronary heart disease, myocardial infarction, sentinel lymph node, metastatic bone tumors, liver and gallbladder disease in children are introduced. Finally, the applications of radionuclide ^{131}I on treatments of Graves' disease and differentiated thyroid cancer and metastases are investigated respectively. This book is a useful reference for professionals engaged in nuclear medicine and clinical research, including clinical nuclear medicine physicians, nuclear medicine engineers and nuclear medicine pharmacists.
