The dolls' wardrobes not only reflect their unique personalities but also the styles of 1860s New England. Outfits include everyday dresses and formal wear as well as nightgowns, coats, and hats. A full-color background scene appears on the inside covers.

A time to reflect on my seventy years of life. Maybe some folks will be interested in my life and the folks I have met, or maybe not.
