Some continue the tradition of using these pieces for special occasions, while others display theirs as a reminder of another time. As early as the 1920s, some glass companies intentionally produced sugars and creamers simply for their collectible nature; and it's not uncommon to find pieces with their original

her as HeLa. She was a poor Southern tobacco farmer
who worked the same land as her slave ancestors, yet
her cells—taken without her knowledge—became one of
