entertaining and compulsively readable novel. Fury is a pitiless comedy that lays bare, with spectacular insight and much glee, the darkest side of human nature. Sacred Fire: Torah from the Years of Fury (1939-1942) consists of commentaries on each weekly Torah portion.
