Between 1981 and 2006, the divorce rate among adult Catholics in the United States had increased from approximately 16% to 25%. In response to this, the candidate worked with 10 voluntary couples preparing for marriage and went over with each couple each item from their responses to the FOCCUS inventory in which they deviated individually or as a couple from the preferred response. He used as his guides for his interactions with these couples Blessed John Paul II's. *The Acting Person*, *Love and Responsibility*, *The Theology of the Body*, *Human Love in the Divine Plan*, and *Familiaris Consortio*. To validate his work, the candidate asked every individual within the 10 couples to complete the inventory a second time using a T-test to determine the significance of the differences. This book reflects what the editor has learned from teaching relationship development and family life education courses over the past decade and includes the key information that students need to become competent professionals. Highlights of the book's coverage include: Comprehensive summary of effective evidence-based RME training programs in one volume. Prepares readers for professional practice as a Certified Family Life Educator (CFLE) by highlighting the fundamentals of developing RME programs. Describes the challenges associated with RME program evaluation. The book opens with a historical overview of RME development. It is followed by 20 chapters divided in six parts.
