

Hello Baby Animals A High Contrast Book

Presents high-contrast illustrations of faces that introduce young readers to different types of people, emotions, and characteristics. Baby animals come in many different shapes and sizes, and many of those shapes and sizes are covered in spots or stripes. In *Baby Animals Spots & Stripes*, each turn of the page reveals a pair of adorable baby animals—one spotted and one striped. On the back cover of the book is a list of the animals featured (mammals, reptiles, birds, and fish). The book closes with a full-color illustration of babies playing with toy versions of each animal. This title is a companion to the best-selling *Baby Animals Black and White*. The bold black-and-white patterns stimulate eyesight and brain development in infants. The recognition and naming of familiar animals promotes speech development in older babies and infants.
