Previously, Betit published *Phu Bai*, *Kagnew Station* and *The Man In The Canal*, military crime novels set in South Vietnam, Ethiopia and Sweden, respectively, during the late 60s and early 70s. That series follows the adventures of U.S. Army CID investigator John Murphy. During book talks promoting his crime novels Betit sometimes read early versions of a few of the stories in *Let Me Tell A Story* at his events. "It was a good change of pace and the stories were well received," he said. "Like my other books, this book can be classified as a good read."

In addition, *Thecla* is presented as a strong willed woman who took it upon herself to preach, teach, heal, and baptize, all without permission or oversight from a man. In the age when canon was being decided, women in positions of leadership within the church was an anomaly, and the idea that a wife could decide her own fate, and even withhold sex

from her husband was looked on as heresy and insolence. These were social constraints, which tainted the interpretation of scripture, both then and now.
