Over 7,000 people have been legally executed in the United States this century, and over 3,000 men and women now sit on death rows across the country awaiting the same fate. Since the Supreme Court temporarily halted capital punishment in 1972, the death penalty has returned with a vengeance. How does capital punishment express the new politics of crime, organize positions in the "culture war," and affect the structure of American values?
