Segundo o Novo Catecismo da Igreja Católica (1992), “no centro da catequese encontramos essencialmente uma Pessoa, a de Jesus Cristo de Nazaré, Filho único do Pai (...)”.

Portanto veremos que a finalidade definitiva da catequese é levar à comunhão com Jesus Cristo: só Ele pode conduzir ao Amor do Pai no Espírito e fazer-nos participar da vida da Santíssima Trindade. Todo catequista deveria poder aplicar a si mesmo a misteriosa Palavra de Jesus: ‘Minha doutrina não é minha, mas daquele que me enviou’ (Jo 7,16)” (NCIC, 426-427). Vamos meditar que, em sua origem, o termo “catequese” diz respeito à proclamação da Palavra. O termo se liga a um verbo que significa “Fazer”, “Ecoar” (gr. Kat-ekhéo). The perfect introductory text, 'The Attributes of God' also has enough depth and meat to satisfy the more experienced reader.
