

## Officina Darte Il Mio Primo Corso Di Storia Dellarte 5

"L'ampia opera pubblicata nel 1962 da H.M. Wingler sul Bauhaus, si rivela ancora oggi utilissima. Nei confronti di altre opere precedentemente scritte sullo stesso argomento, la sua originalità consisteva nel fatto che per la prima volta si cercava di fornire una storia completa del Bauhaus, cioè non frammentaria. Un altro aspetto dell'originalità del libro di Wingler era dato dal suo carattere di antologia di documenti: per la prima volta esso offriva al grande pubblico la possibilità di valutare direttamente dei documenti e così formulare un giudizio su fatti e idee e non, come era avvenuto fino a quel momento, su 'opinioni' intorno a fatti e idee. Anche se la documentazione presentata da Wingler non era del tutto esauriente, essa era sicuramente la più ampia rispetto ad altre precedenti. E anche successive. The eminent art historian Roberto Longhi honored him as "the most energetic and passionate of Caravaggio's naturalist followers." In Rome, Valentin—who loved the tavern as much as the painter's palette—fell in with a rowdy confederation of artists but eventually received commissions from some of the city's most prominent patrons. It was in this artistically rich but violent metropolis that Valentin created such masterworks as a major altarpiece in Saint Peter's Basilica and superb renderings of biblical and secular subjects—until his tragic death at the age of forty-one cut short his ascendant career. With discussions of nearly fifty works, representing practically all of his painted oeuvre, *Valentin de Boulogne: Beyond Caravaggio* explores both the the artist's superlative depictions of daily life and the tumultuous context in which they were produced. Essays by a team of international scholars consider his key attributions to European painting, his devotion to everyday objects and models from life, his technique of staging pictures with the immediacy of unfolding drama, and his place in the pantheon of French artists. An extensive chronology surveys the rare extant documents that chronicle his biography, while individual entries help situate his works in the contexts of his times. Rich with incident and insight, and beautifully illustrated in Valentin's complex, suggestive paintings, *Valentin de Boulogne: Beyond Caravaggio* reveals a seminal artist, a practitioner of realism in the seventeenth century who prefigured the naturalistic modernism of Gustave Courbet and Edouard Manet two centuries later.

È stata una vita inquieta, quella di Hans Werner Henze, fra i più significativi compositori contemporanei e certo fra i più amati. La vita di un uomo posseduto dalla musica, fin dalla più tenera età; di un uomo che non ha mai smesso di ascoltare gli altri, e che agli altri ha fatto dono non solo della propria arte ma anche del proprio inesausto impegno civile, speso nella recisa contestazione di ogni ingiustizia. Da ogni incontro prende vita una comunione di intelligenze che porta a una composizione, in uno slancio umano e artistico che non sembra conoscere limiti, se non per superarli ogni volta. Nel novantesimo anniversario dalla nascita di Henze, il Saggiatore porta in libreria un'edizione arricchita e completamente aggiornata di Canti di viaggio, curata da Gastón Fournier-Facio, Michael Kerstan ed Elena Minetti. A Canti di viaggio il compositore ha affidato la sua postrema eredità: nutrito di una scrittura imprevedibile come la sua musica – una scrittura in cui si mescolano lirismo struggente e annotazioni telegrafiche, attenzione icastica al particolare e vaste visioni ideali –, questo memoriale non è solo la testimonianza diretta di uno dei più grandi intellettuali del XX secolo, ma anche, e soprattutto, una sinfonia in prosa capace di modulare tutte le note del sentimento.

By looking at two profoundly diverse aesthetic phenomena within the context of the creation of a Fascist State art, Billiani and Pennacchietti argue that an effort of construction, or reconstruction, was the main

driving force behind both projects: the advocated "revolution" of the novel form (realism) and that of architecture (rationalism). The book is divided into seven chapters, which in turn analyze the interconnections between the novel and architecture in theory and in practice. The first six chapters cover debates on State art, on the novel and on architecture, as well as their historical development and their unfolding in key journals of the period. The last chapter offers a detailed analysis of some important novels and buildings, which have in practice realized some of the key principles articulated in the theoretical disputes. Francesca Billiani is Senior Lecturer in Italian Studies and Director of the Centre for Interdisciplinary Research in the Arts and Languages at the University of Manchester, UK. Laura Pennacchietti is Research Associate in Italian Studies at the University of Manchester, UK.

Cosimo di Rondó, a young Italian nobleman of the eighteenth century, rebels against his parents by climbing into the trees and remaining there for the rest of his life. The Schumann Marriage diaries provide a vivid portrait of the unique artistic and personal union between two renowned musicians. For the first four years of their marriage, Robert and Clara Schumann kept a joint diary, recording their entries, at least initially, on alternate weeks. Begun on September 13, 1840, the day after their marriage, the diary opens with guidance from Robert: "This little book . . . has a very intimate meaning; it shall be a diary about everything that touches us mutually in our household and marriage." The diaries reflect the harmony as well as the discord in their marriage. Robert and Clara describe in intimate detail their honeymoon period, the births of their children, their busy social lives, travels throughout Europe, financial problems, separations, and reunions. The book also evokes the artistic milieu of nineteenth-century Germany. The Schumanns came in contact with many musicians, including their close friends Felix Mendelssohn and Franz Liszt, and recorded their insightful reactions to the artists and their music. The marriage diaries cover a fertile period in Robert Schumann's life, during which he wrote the Spring Symphony, the Piano Concerto, most of his chamber music, his first oratorio, "Paradise and the Peri," and numerous songs. They reflect the frenetic pace at which he worked, as well as his growing bouts of depression, his ambivalent response to Clara's decision to return to the concert stage after a prolonged hiatus, and her anxiety in the face of Robert's changing moods. This edition includes the couple's travel book, written during their stressful concert tour of Russia in 1844, which marked the end of the marriage diaries; Robert Schumann's descriptions of Russian customs; and the poems he wrote in Moscow - all of which provide a fascinating and uniquely detailed glimpse at what it was like to travel in Russia at the time.
