The first Vauxhall car left a cramped Thames-side works in 1903. Moving to Luton in 1905, Vauxhall became famous as a maker of sporting and luxury cars. Bought by the American giant General Motors, the company entered the era of mass production and, with the addition of Bedford trucks and vans, became one of the top five UK producers. After the Second World War, Vauxhall became the household name it is today with models such as Viva, Astra, Cresta, Victor, Nova, Cavalier and Vivaro. The journey from the Thames to today's plants at Ellesmere Port and Luton is full of twists, turns, dramas and triumphs, and continues with the announcement of the sale of General Motors European operations to the PSA Groupe. The author worked at Vauxhall for 38 years, from apprentice to boardroom. He has told the Vauxhall story with the benefit of years of experience and a lifelong passion for the marque.

Extracto: El Opel Corsa es un automóvil de turismo del segmento B desarrollado por el fabricante alemán Opel, es idéntico a su versión británica bajo el alero de Vauxhall también es comercializado bajo las marcas de Chevrolet y Holden. todas ellas pertenecientes a la multinacional americana General Motors. El Corsa se fabrica en Figueruelas, España; en Eisenach, Alemania; y ha sido fabricado en Sudafrica, en Rosario, Argentina; en Brasil, México, Colombia, Venezuela, Chile, Ecuador, India y China. El Opel Corsa (Vauxhall Nova en la primera generación) representó el primer intento de la General Motors europea para lanzar al mercado un automóvil pequeño, mucho más tarde que el Ford Fiesta y el Volkswagen Polo, dos de sus principales rivales. En 1982 se abrió la planta de Zaragoza para producir en 1983 el Corsa A. En su lanzamiento, se ofrecía con carrocerías hatchback y sedan, y con motores de gasolina de 1,0 (OHV), 1,2, 1,3 y posteriormente 1,4 litros de cilindrada (OHC). Más tarde apareció el Corsa 1.3SR, impulsado por el 1,3 OHC litros de flujo cruzado, acoplado a una caja de cambios de 5 velocidades. En 1985, el 1.3SR toma un carburador Pierburg 2E3 con doble cuerpo, y starter automático, con denominación "GT." En 1988 se presentó el Corsa GSi, con motor 1,6 litros OHC de 100 hp. Este modelo cambió de nombre en 1990 cuando pasó a llamarse GSi. El lanzamiento del motor Diesel, de origen Isuzu, se produjo en 1987, disponible en versiones atmosférica de 50 CV de potencia máxima y con turbocompresor de 67 CV. Para 1989, el SR recibe un motor más grande (1389cc) con cierre central, vidrios tintados y...

In 1965, Colin Chapman persuaded Ford to underwrite development of a V8 for the new 3000cc Grand Prix formula. Built by Cosworth, the new DFV engine won Lotus four World Championship Grands Prix in 1967. A year later, and now available to other
