One of the most-talked about new plays of the 2016 Off-Broadway season, Sarah DeLappe's *The Wolves* opened to enthusiastic acclaim, including two sold-out, extended runs at The Playwrights Realm/The Duke on 42nd Street. *The Wolves* follows the 9 teenage girls—members of an indoor soccer team—as they warm up, engage in banter and one-upmanship, and fight battles big and small with each other and themselves. As the teammates warm up in sync, a symphony of overlapping dialogue spills out their concerns, including menstruation (pads or tampons?), is Coach hung over?, eating disorders, sexual pressure, the new girl, and the Khmer Rouge (what it is, how to pronounce it, and do they need to know about it—“We don't do genocides 'til senior year.†?") By season's and play's end, amidst the wins and losses, rivalries and tragedies, they are warriors tested and ready—they are *The Wolves*.

SHOT TO PIECES is the story of NYPD 1st Grade Detective Padraig Joseph Durr. Durr is tasked with solving a particularly grisly gang related homicide in Brooklyn. When Paddy catches the squeal, he is also on the verge of an emotional and psychological breakdown. Because of his penchant for self-destruction, fueled by a childhood of abuse and sexual exploitation, coupled with an ingrained sense of worthlessness and abandonment, Durr has brought his entire life to the brink of ruin. Can he hold it together long enough to

solve this murder? Can he fix himself enough to be re-united with the one true love of his life and his family? Or will he implode, irrevocably destroying his career, his family and himself?

Once every generation there comes along a book that both lifts the spirit and inspires the mind. Crossmaglen Paddy Said is one of those rare published gems. This is not a book to be read just for laughs, as it contains a mix of tragedy and comedy. It is a true story. All incidents mentioned happened as they are described and at that time and place. In the words of an eminent professional who first read the manuscript, "This book does not follow any set plot or order. Perhaps this is intentional, and you are going for a James Joyce stream of consciousness effect, or Beckett, where everything happens with only one or two characters in one room on one day, or Flann O'Brien's writings, where there are surreal theories and weird characters, and the reader has the sense of entering a strange world." It has been compared by a Hollywood producer with Conor McPherson's Laurence Olivier award-winning play *The Weir*, which won the Play of the Year award in 1999. Crossmaglen Paddy Said contains authentic evidence of the British ships and regiments who exported the food off the island of Ireland during the period of the Great Hunger from 1845 to 1950. Inside, it also draws a unique paralleled comparison between an incident that occurred relating to Crossmaglen on August 15, 1971, and Boston Massachusetts on the March 5, 1770, the most important date in American history. In the second phase, this book becomes an inspirational story, which details and outlines the lifetime achievements of both Paddy and the narrator, Paudraic Moore. It then becomes a super motivational tool for its readers.

A young woman has been murdered, and a neighbour, a retired teacher from Chapleton College, is arrested. An eccentric loner - intellectual, shy, a fastidious dresser with expensive tastes - he is the perfect candidate for a media monsterring. In custody he is interviewed by two detectives: the smart-talking, quick-witted Gary, and his watchful colleague, Ander. Ander is always watchful, but particularly now, because the man across the table is his former teacher Michael Wolphram, whom he hasn't seen in nearly 30 years. As the novel proceeds, we watch Wolphram's media lynching as ex-pupils and colleagues line up to lie about him. In

parallel, we read Ander's memories of his life as a young Dutch boy in 80s England. Another outsider, another loner in a school system rife with abuse and bullying, Ander has another case to solve: the cold case of his own childhood. Though it deals with historical abuse and violence in schools, and the corrupt power of the popular media, *Throw Me to the Wolves* is mostly about childhood and memory. Childhood crushes, like childhood toys, are meant to be left behind with the arrival of adulthood. So why is it that Josie Collins finds herself still attracted to her childhood crush, her brother's friend Simon London, even after eight years? Eight years which have turned Simon from cute to incredibly well-built and sexy. Josie already has enough issues of her own, including a recent breakup which has somersaulted her onto a path of self-destruction. She doesn't need a complication like Simon to add to her problems. Simon London has returned to Portland after an eight-year absence, now a successful architect who can write his own ticket. When he reconnects with the family who accepted and cared for him during a rough time in his life, the last thing he wants or expects is to develop feelings for his friend's younger sister, Josie. When he overhears disturbing information about what Josie has been through, his protective nature takes over, and he's determined to find a way to protect Josie. So how does one get into the Masquerade Club? Josie's

friend Emmie suggests the Masquerade Club to Josie as a way to safely blow off steam and redirect her self-destructive tendencies. When Josie agrees to the plan, she doesn't count on meeting the sexy Wolf. She finds herself thinking about him, even when she's at work at the gym she owns in downtown Portland. But she also has Simon on her mind far more than she would like. To make matters worse, her ex refuses to take no for an answer. What's a girl to do? How do you choose between the unknown and the forbidden?

Today Patrick Lahey chooses to be sober and to battle the storm. It is his hope that others will also choose to fight while finding their passion, following their dreams, and opening and sharing the gift inside with the world, all while remembering they are loved and never alone.
