Cuando se actúa sobre el estrato arbustivo, la limpia se denomina desbroce. A lo largo del primer capítulo del libro se recoge una clasificación de los diferentes tipos de desbroces, así como de la variedad de máquinas que los operarios forestales pueden emplear para llevar a cabo esta labor, tratando especialmente las denominadas motodesbrozadoras. El estudio se centrará fundamentalmente en la amplia variedad de útiles de corte que estas máquinas pueden portar. En el segundo se describen todas aquellas labores y tareas que el operario debe realizar para el cuidado, mantenimiento y puesta a punto de la motodesbrozadora.
