CHAPTER III. Of Concealed Assets (sonogados). Art. 1780.

The heir who conceals (sonegar) property of the estate, not describing it in the inventory, when it is in his power, or with his knowledge in that of another, or who omits it in the collation into which he should bring it, or who fails to restore it, shall lose the right which he may have to it. Art. 1781.

Besides the penalty provided (comminada) in the preceding Article, if the concealer is the maker of the inventory, he shall be removed upon proof of the concealment, or if he denies the existence of the property, when it is indicated. Art. 1782.

The penalty for concealment can only be demanded and imposed in an ordinary action, brought by the heirs or by the creditors of the estate. Single Paragraph. The sentence which is rendered in the action for concealment, brought by any of the heirs or creditors, benefits the other interested parties.

Art. 1783. If the property concealed is not restored, because no longer in his power, he shall pay the amount of its value, besides the losses and damages. Art. 1784. The maker of the...
