His forgiveness makes it possible for them to imitate his own forgiveness, and it enables them to resume their mission of caring - feeding the hungry, giving a drink to the thirsty, as the road leading to eternal life. Forgiving one another leads to reconciliation, and it fulfils Jesus' prayer for his disciples shortly before his death - that they might be united with him, and through him, to his heavenly Father. In its reconciled state, the disobedience and scattering of humanity after its 'fall' in the Garden of Eden, are undone.
