The first part of the book considers the issue of purpose by looking at the role of the school in society and then shows the place that geography occupies within it. The second part is a practical guide which illustrates how to put this theory of curriculum purpose into practice. It will also discuss the extent to which teachers need to consider the future and respond to the concerns of the wider world when planning the curriculum.
